Please attend our Easter services Sunday April 1st starting with Sunday school at 10AM and the worship service at 11

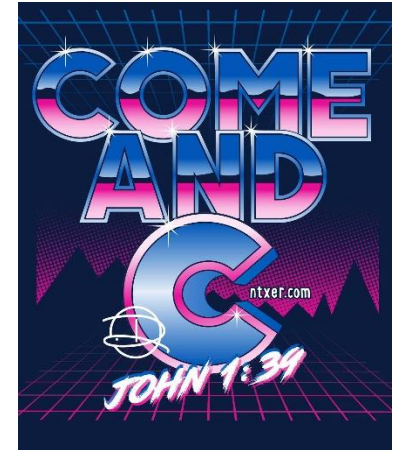
